Religion Alongside Politics in America Three Components of a Moral Revolution: Something that was nearly universally <u>condemned</u> is now nearly universally celebrated. That which was celebrated is condemned Those who refuse to celebrate are condemned Moral concerns such as personal character and family stability questions have been marginalized in both of the major political parties, leaving evangelicals politically homeless whether they know it or not. In other words <u>exiled</u> The Benedict Option -Micro-Christendoms -The Evangelical Persecution Complex -The Jeremiah Option -<u>Dual Perspectives of Jews Returning From Exile - Ezra 3:1-13</u> The focus of the Jews as they returned to their homeland is <u>worship</u> A. Feasts (vs. 4); Offerings (vs. 5); Orderliness (vs. 8-9); Praise and singing (vs. 10-11) Their worship was structured according to the Word of the Lord. A. The priests and Levites took their places. (I Chron. 25:1) They sang psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs. (vs. 11 and Psalm 100) They practiced corporate worship. (vs. 12) At the laying of the foundation for the temple, notice the reactions of the older members vs. the others. A. The older members <u>wept</u> while the others <u>rejoiced</u> Do we see a similar divergence in American believers when it comes to <u>political perspectives</u>? Older believers are generally more likely to perceive America as Israel .

7.	Fight against the <u>merging</u> of faith and politics. They are not the same thing, and to make them so Is <u>idolatrous</u> .
