#### **B. Helpful Categories for the 18 Separate "Gifts":**

1. I Corinthians 12:6-10
2. I Corinthians 12:28 → The "**MANIFESTATIONAL**" Gifts → "**WHAT**"?
3. I Corinthians 12:29-30 ("passed away/ceased")
4. Ephesians 4:11 → The "**MINISTRY**" Gifts! → "**WHERE**"?  
(Body "leadership")
5. Romans 12:6-8 → The "**MOTIVATIONAL**" Gifts! → "**WHY**"?  
(“each Believer possesses one”)
6. I Peter 4:11 → The Gifts = "Speaking" or "Serving".

## **Helpful Observations about the Believer's "Motivational" Gift**

### **I. The Believer \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus Christ because He first loved "His own",**

*"Now before the Feast of the Passover, Jesus knowing that His hour had come that He would depart out of this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end."* John 13:1

A. This statement is \_\_\_\_\_ → the end of His life!

B. This statement is \_\_\_\_\_ → the deepest depth of sacrifice!

*"Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. The one who does not love does not know God, for God is love. By this the love of God was manifested in us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world so that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that **He loved us** and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another."* I John 4:7-11

*"Whoever confesses that Jesus is the Son of God, God abides in him, and he in God. We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. **God is love**, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in Him. . . . **We love, because He first loved us.**"* I John 4:15-16,19

Observations: The "love of God" is . . .

-- An attribute of His \_\_\_\_\_ → who He is!

-- Demonstrated by the sacrificial \_\_\_\_\_ of His Son → what He invested!

-- Demonstrated by the sacrificial \_\_\_\_\_ of His Body → the spiritual gifts!

*"But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good."*

I Corinthians 12:7

Observation: The "spiritual gifts" provided to Believers at salvation are a summary \_\_\_\_\_ of the "love" of Christ!

**Prophecy → Service → Teaching → Exhortation → Giving → Administration → Mercy!**

*"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have **loved** you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another."* John 13:34-35

Key: The function of each gift is required for the collective Body to show God's love!

*"For even as the body is one and yet has many members . . . so also is Christ . . . But God has composed the body, giving more abundant honor to that member which lacked, so that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another."* I Corinthians 12:12, 24-25

## II. Each Believer has only “\_\_\_\_\_” Spiritual Gift. WHY?

A. So that there is no \_\_\_\_\_ in our motivation!

B. So that there is a true spirit of \_\_\_\_\_ in the Body!

*“For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you not to think more highly of himself than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith. For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.”*  
Romans 12:3-5

→ the Body of Christ is “\_\_\_\_\_”!

## III. While the individual “Sign” or “Manifestational” Gifts have been “done away”, I Corinthians 13:8, many of the same “effects” are accomplished by the Holy Spirit while the individual “Motivational” Gifts are being exercised.
