The Significance of Gathered Worship for Adults and Children
1. Gathering regularly with the church for worship is a key part of our
<u>1 Tim. 4:6-8</u> — ⁶ If you put these things before the brothers, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, <u>being trained</u> in the words of the faith and of the good doctrine that you have followed. ⁷ Have nothing to do with irreverent, silly myths. Rather <u>train yourself</u> for godliness; ⁸ for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.
2. When we gather for worship we publically to Christ and His Word.
Acts 1:8—But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth."
3. Gathering for worship allows the opportunity for mutual
<u>Heb. 10:24-25—</u> ²⁴ And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, ²⁵ not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some but encouraging one another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.
4. It is within the context of the local church that we demonstrate practical to the authority of God in our lives.
