- A. <u>A Penetrating Question</u> à "What is happening in my life?" (Do I really know?)
- B. The First of Five Eternal Perspectives:
- à God has begun a "good work" in my life which He is "perfecting", Phil. 1:6.
- "For I am confident of this very thing, that He who <u>began</u> a **good work** in you

will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus."

- a. That <u>Good Work</u> is to "_____" every Believer in Jesus Christ,
- bringing a "<u>new standing</u>" before God which is unchangeable and secure!
- --My "<u>Justification</u>" à I have been "declared righteous" by God through Christ.
 - b. That Good Work is "perfected" in the Believer's

 by the

process of "<u>conformity</u>" to Christ, preparing every Believer for eternity!

- --My "<u>Sanctification</u>" à Christ's holiness is being worked out in my life!
- c. Failure to walk in "______" as a Believer hinders God's perfecting
- "conformity" to Christ and brings the Father's loving "discipline"/"child-training":
- --Loss of <u>time</u>, <u>joy</u>, and <u>opportunity</u> à "<u>prodigal delay</u>" or "leanness of soul".

1. <u>In All Believers</u>: New "<u>Life</u>" à A New "<u>Nature</u>" à New "DESIRES"!

a. II Corinthians 5:17-18

"Therefore if anyone is <u>in</u> Christ, he is a <u>new creature</u>; the old things passed away; behold, <u>new things</u> have come. Now all these things are from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ..."

b. II Corinthians 5:14-15

"For <u>the love of Christ controls us</u>, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died; and He died for all, <u>so that they who live might no longer live for themselves</u>, but <u>for Him</u> who died and rose again on their behalf."

c. <u>Ephesians 3:16-19</u>

2. Galatians 2:20

"I have been crucified with Christ; and it is no longer I who life, but Christ lives in me; and the life which I now live in the <u>flesh</u> I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself up for me."

Helpful Observations On Earthly "Will" and "Obedience"

1. God is at "work" to produce a "DESIRE" for His will in our lives, Phil. 2:13.

àThis "desire" is part of our <u>New Nature</u>, the <u>Life</u> of Christ in us!

à This "desire" grows as we grow spiritually by <u>feeding on</u> the Word of God!

à This "desire" grows into maturity as the Holy Spirit sovereignly deals with us

in the events of life – to "<u>release</u>" us from the "love of the world"!

2. God is at "work" to produce faithful "OBEDIENCE" in our lives, Phil 2:13

à Faithful "obedience" is the release of the <u>power</u> of God, the Holy Spirit!

à Faithful "obedience" is the natural by-product of "walking

by the Spirit!"

à Faithful "obedience" brings the highest level of <u>meaning</u> and <u>purpose</u> into

human experience – the **thrill** of "losing" our life in the will of God!
