I. The Promises of God Regarding the Coming Year!

A. Isaiah 40:31

"Yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles; they will run and not get tired; they will walk and not become weary."

B. <u>Isaiah 41:10</u>

"Do not fear, for I am with you; do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God. I will <u>strengthen</u> you, surely I will <u>help</u> you, surely I will <u>uphold</u> you with My righteous right hand."

C. <u>Isaiah 46:8,9,10,11</u>

"Remember this, and be assured ('firm'); recall it to mind . . .
Remember the things long past, for I am God and there is no other;
I am God and there is no one like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times things which have not been seen, saying 'My purpose will be established and I will accomplish all My good pleasure' . . . Truly I have spoken; truly I will bring it to pass. I have planned it, surely I will do it."

D. Psalm 32:6-10

"Therefore, let everyone who is godly <u>pray to You</u> in a time when You may be found; surely in a flood of great waters they will not reach him. You are my <u>hiding place</u>; You <u>preserve me</u> from trouble; You <u>surround me</u> with songs of deliverance. <u>Selah</u> I will <u>instruct you</u> and <u>teach you</u> in the way you should go; <u>I will counsel you</u> with My eye upon you. Do not be as the horse or the mule which have no understanding, whole trappings include bit and bridle to hold them in check, otherwise they will not come near to you. Many are the sorrows of the wicked, but he who <u>trusts in the Lord</u>, **lovingkindness** shall surround him."

E. Ephesians 1:3, 18-19

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. . . . I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened, so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the surpassing greatness of His power toward us who believe."

F. Romans 8:18, 31-32, 35-37

"For I consider that the <u>sufferings</u> of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that is to be revealed to us. . . . What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him over for us all, how will He not also with Him <u>freely give us all things?</u> . . . Who will separate us from the love of Christ? Will tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Just as it is written, 'For Your sake we are being put to death all day long; we were considered as sheep to be slaughtered.' But <u>in all these things we overwhelmingly conquer through Him who loved us.</u>"

G. Philippians 4:13, 19

"I can do <u>all things</u> through Him who strengthens me. ... And my God will <u>supply all</u> <u>your needs</u> according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

II. Admonitions/Commands to the Believer!

- A. "But <u>grow</u> in the <u>grace</u> and <u>knowledge</u> of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."
 - 1) How?

"Like newborn babies, long for the <u>pure milk of the Word</u>, so that by it you may <u>grow</u> in respect to salvation, if you have tasted the kindness of the Lord." I Peter 2:2-3 "Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, <u>accurately handling</u> the word of truth."

2) Why?

"But evil men and imposters will proceed from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. You, however, continue in the things you have learned and become convinced of, knowing from whom you have learned them . . . All Scripture is inspired by God ('God-breathed') and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness; so that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work."

"For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you have need again for someone to teach you the elementary principles of the oracles of God, and you have come to need <u>milk</u> and not solid food. For everyone who partakes only of <u>milk</u> is not accustomed to the word of righteousness, for <u>he is an infant</u>. But solid food is for the mature, who because of <u>practice</u> have their senses trained to discern good and evil."

- B. "Therefore be careful how you walk, not as unwise men but as wise, making the most of ('redeeming') your time, because the days are evil. So then do not be foolish, but understand what the will of the Lord is."

 - 1) How?

"But when the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth... whatever He hears, He will speak, and disclose to you what is to come. He will glorify Me, for He will take of Mine and disclose it to you. All things that the Father has are Mine; therefore I said that He takes of Mine and will disclose it to you." John 16:13-15

2) Why?

"Therefore I urge you, by the mercies of God, to <u>present</u> your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, <u>acceptable</u> ('well-pleasing) to God, which is your spiritual service of worship. And do not be <u>conformed to this world</u> (system), but be <u>transformed</u> by the <u>renewing</u> of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is <u>good</u> and <u>acceptable</u> ('well-pleasing') and perfect." Romans 12:1-2
