 - 2. The "Growth" truths deal with <u>Sanctification</u> → How we are enabled to grow in the faith and live the "new" life God has given → the "Christ-life" for the "Self-life"!
- --<u>Application</u> provides practical instruction on the issues of human experience → describing the "fruit of the Spirit" -vs- the sinful "deeds of the flesh"!
