"God's Weapons For Victory In Relationships!"

We have observed that <u>Satan</u> has "<u>weapons</u>" ('schemes') which he likes to use against a marriage or any other relationship which should be marked by God's "love":

Does <u>God</u> have "<u>weapons</u>" which He provides to Believers to "<u>defend</u>" against Satan's schemes or to "<u>heal</u>" the damage he has already done?

"For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh: For <u>the weapons</u> of our warfare are not of the flesh, but <u>divinely powerful</u> for the destruction of fortresses. We are <u>destroying</u> speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God, and we are <u>taking every</u> thought captive to the obedience of Christ."

Paul emphasizes that there is a real "war" going in the Believer's "" between the thinking of our "Old Man" and our "New Man"! Attempting to "war" or "fight" spiritual battles by "" thinking is powerless and fruitless! "Surface" patterns and issues might change, but never reaches the real "Source" of the problem!
Note: The Bible is not a " " manual. God does not the "flesh" to make " " changes! The imperatives ("commands") of the N.T. are not addressed to the "Old Man"!
Paul declares that the Believer has a different arsenal → "weapons" not of the "flesh", but the "Spirit"! These spiritual weapons are "Divinely Powerful"! They are able to "destroy" or "demolish":
a) Spiritual " <u>fortresses</u> " or "" which have been built up in our minds; (The "World-system" is designed to " <u>saturate</u> " the Believer's mind/thinking!)
b) Philosophical/Theological " <u>speculations</u> " about ultimate truth → personal ""! ("Everyone has the <u>right</u> to their opinion, but that does not make their opinion <u>right</u> !")
c) Prideful or "lofty things" raised up against the (true) knowledge of God! (John 17:17)
Paul summarizes the "secret" of spiritual victory -> " bringing every thought captive to the obedience of CHRIST!" (Every "thought" aligned with the Word of God!)
