"<u>Captured By Love</u>" Understanding God's Eternal Purpose! Romans 8:28-29

Introduction:

Many of us have had the wonderful experience of "falling in love" – of being **"smitten"** in a relationship which becomes a life-long experience of **"oneness"** in marriage. That experience can be described as being **"captured"** by a love relationship! Remarkably, this human experience is filled with eternal purpose – the blueprint of what God had in mind when he created us for relationship with Him for eternity!! Even if meaningful marriage has not been our experience in life, we can still observe and appreciate God's intention for the relationship of human marriage.

"And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are <u>called</u> according to <u>His purpose</u>. For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become <u>conformed to the image of His Son</u>, so that He would be the <u>firstborn among many brethren</u>." Romans 8:28-29

The heart of the Son of God toward His Father was <u>careful obedience to His will</u>! This is what "<u>love</u>" looked like between Father and Son. So, because we are created in God's image, we have the capacity to be born again into the "<u>image</u>" of the Son of God. God <u>grows us</u> as His children into the same <u>image</u> – that of His Son! This is God's <u>eternal purpose</u> for each of His children! This is His heart's desire!

→ This morning, I want to talk to you about your "<u>Heart</u>"... what has "captured" your heart? → <u>Fact</u>: Each of us is living ... "<u>captured</u>" or "<u>controlled</u>" by what we <u>love</u> in our heart!

Interesting Background to our Study:

In the Book of Job, 1:6-12, when that Godly man, <u>Job</u>, and his family were coming to an altar to worship God, Satan came into that time of worship, and challenged God with this "<u>accusation</u>", "Does Job fear God for nothing? Have you not made a hedge about him and his house and all he has, on every side? You have blessed the work of his hands, and his possessions have increased in the land. <u>But put forth your hand now and touch all that he **has; he will surely curse You to Your face.**"</u>

God's reply set forth <u>the underlying battle between Satan and God in human history:</u> "Behold, all that he has is in your power, only do not put forth your hand on him." (You may "<u>test</u>" his heart!)

<u>Satan's Challenge to God</u>: "No one will love You for <u>who</u> You are; they will only love You for <u>what</u> You do for them!"

--<u>Note</u>: These events occurred <u>before</u> God called Abraham to leave his home in Ur of the Chaldees to <u>found a Nation ("Israel</u>") who would be God's "<u>Chosen People</u>"!

"You adulteresses, do you not know that friendship with the world is hostility toward God? Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. Or do you think that the Scripture speaks to no purpose: 'He jealously desires the Spirit which He has made to dwell in us?' " -- James 4:4-5

--What is "friendship with the world"?

--What is the meaning of "He jealously desires the Spirit ... "?

A. God takes this seriously!!! It really matters to Him!

--Israel's O.T. history: Jeremiah 32:30, 33-34

"Indeed the sons of Israel and the sons of Judah have been doing only evil in My sight from their youth, for the sons of Israel have been only provoking Me to anger by the work of their hands, declares the LORD... They have turned their back to Me and not their face; though I taught them, teaching them again and again, they would not listen and receive instruction. But they put their detestable things in the house which is called by My name, to defile it."

--God sees rejection of His love as "Idolatry" and "Spiritual Adultery"!

--Note: God "<u>set Israel aside</u>" temporarily because of their <u>rejection</u> of His love and chose a different group → A group of "<u>Called-Out Ones</u>" who would "<u>Love</u>" Him from the heart →

The " --Note: Jesus Christ would "_____ "their hearts! "Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the boastful pride of life, is not from the Father, but is from the world. The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does *the will of God* lives forever." I John 2:15-17 --Note: The "World-System": → Satan is the "_____" of this World-System! (II Cor. 4:4) →It is structured to demand "_____" to its values/approval! (Rom. 12:2) \rightarrow It is described in Scripture as a "_____"! (II Timothy 4:3-4) (A "concoction" of the mind!) --Contrast: Personal Love of the "Good Shepherd": \rightarrow Jesus is the "_____" of His Sheep" (John 10:1-5) \rightarrow Key: Whose "_____" do I hear? _____"? or, --The "Shepherd" Who walks in the "_ "? --The "Thief", the "Robber", the "Wolf" who walks in "_____ --The Future for the Child of God:

"For we all must appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad." II Corinthians 5:10

III. What Does It Mean to be "Captured" by the Love of Christ?

A. Mary Magdalene:

"And there was a woman in the city who was a sinner . . . and standing behind Him at His feet, weeping, she began to wet His feet with her tears, and kept wiping them with the hair of her head, and kissing His feet and anointing them with the perfume." Luke 7:37-38

B. Simon Peter:

"And He said to Him the third time, 'Simon, son of John, do you love me?' Peter was grieved because He said to him the third time, 'Do you love Me?' And he said to Him, 'Lord, You know all things; You know that I love You.' Jesus said to him, 'Tend My sheep.'" John 21:17
